

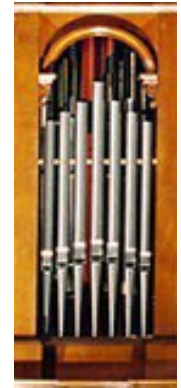

Organ Program at Mercer University

Mercer University, Macon, Georgia, works to offer organ students establish a strong foundation in musically and healthy technique. offers a number of musical degree programs: Bachelor of Music in Performance, Bachelor of Music Education, Bachelor of Music in Elective Studies in an Outside Field, Bachelor of Arts in Music, Master of Music in Church Music, Master of Music in Performance, dual Masters degrees in organ/conducting and organ/collaborative piano, and Artist Diploma. Jack Mitchener is Professor of Organ. Applicants for degrees in organ performance and church music are encouraged to apply by February 15, 2023. Instruction is on the main campus in Macon. Artist Diploma students have the option to study in Macon or Atlanta. Fabian Scholarships for undergraduates are all expenses paid (tuition, room and board, etc) plus additional support for summer study abroad. A pre-screening video is required. Other substantial music and academic scholarships are available. Students have regular access to a diverse collection of organs.
