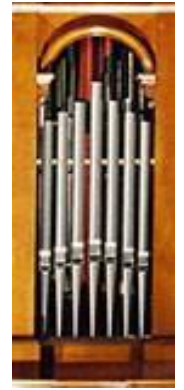

New hymn for Veterans Day now available

Choral planners for the services, ceremonies, and observances of Veterans Day 2022 now have a new resource to consider: a new hymn entitled, “Ever Faithful to the Call.” The hymn can be reviewed and downloaded free for nonprofit use at www.everfaithfultothecall.com.

Composer Tom Lough turned to chaplains, veterans, family members, widows, and church music professionals for their ideas and suggestions in the hymn’s development. Field testing of the hymn in late 2021 provided additional feedback for the final revisions.

The four-verse hymn was sung recently as part of an organ recital in the West Point Cadet Chapel at the United States Military Academy. Craig Williams, chapel organist, said, “I feel this hymn has the potential for widespread use in military and civilian settings for Veterans Day and other occasions as well.”

Lough invites university and church choral leaders to consider incorporating this hymn into their Veterans Day 2022 observances.
